Bourne Classic Car and Bike Show Sunday June 10th 2012

Following the success of the show in 2011, despite the weather, there will be a seventh Classic Car and Bike Show in Bourne Lincolnshire. It is hoped that there will be a good showing of classic and sports cars together with a collection of classic motorbikes.

This year the car and commercial entries must have been built in 1992 or earlier, with the bike entries built in 1985 or earlier. The exception to this will be race cars which have no age restriction and are welcome at the organizers discretion.

Apart from the classic cars and bikes, other attractions will include a hogroast, craft stalls, live music from the Wississippi Jazz Band, a Punch & Judy show and a flypast of the Battle of Britain Memorial Flight etc. The central display this year will consist of a tribute to Lotus.

The field is near the centre of Bourne in which the Raymond Mays museum will be open at Baldocks Mill for those people interested in the racing history of Bourne.

The show will open to the public from 10am to 4 pm. Please note that due to the increasing numbers of cars and numbers of people we have to consider health and safety so there will be no vehicular movement on the show field between 11 am and 4 pm, unless it is for an emergency.

There will be judging of both cars and bikes, the prize will go to the car or bike that the judges think that they would like to take home and use. There will be three main classes, pre 1939, 1940 – 1960 and post 1960 just to add a bit of spice to the day.
